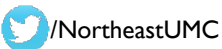
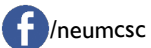

Next Sunday in our worship services we will have a time of “Sending Forth” for youth and adults who are participating in Salkehatchie Summer Service this year.

I have many memories of Salkehatchie experiences – good memories, great memories, and some others as well. Most people who go to Salkehatchie have marvelous experiences, but there are those who don’t “get it.” I’ve been with adults who thought the purpose of Salkehatchie is fixing the house. I’ve been with youth whose agenda was something other than “to be the hands of Christ.” Do persons who go to Salkehatchie get a lot out of the week? Sometimes... Food for thought...

Why do some “get it” while others do not? In my experience, some call on the Lord for help repairing and improving a home.
