# A Song for Our Time Psalm 23 The Lord is my shepherd, I shall not want.


He makes me to lie down in green pastures; he leads me beside still waters; he restores my soul. He leads me in the paths of righteousness for his name's sake.






# Into the Word, Into the World

Chastity Cherubin and Brooks Shealy are prepared to lead a Disciple II curriculum, a 32 week study.
