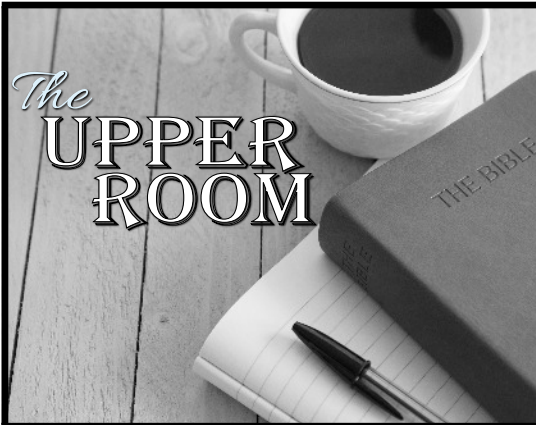

Thoughts on Extravagant Generosity May 2024

“The devil is in the details,” an English language idiom, means that while details may seem of little importance, they may actually have hidden problems that increase likelihood of a plan failing. The saying came into its own in the US in the 1990’s from an adage in German and actually means, (are you ready for this?), “God is in the details”!!

This is probably not surprising to us because the Bible shows how God orchestrates details miraculously and repeatedly, His wonders to behold.

I was reminded of Exodus 3: 21-22 while watching, “Moses: The Old Testament,” during Lent this year. God appeared to Moses in a burning bush to prepare Moses for leading the enslaved Hebrew people out of Egypt. Just think about how the details must have caused Moses to have sleep preventing headaches!

The Scripture says that Moses told the slave women to ask the Egyptian women for silver and gold jewelry and fine garments to take on their journey into the desert. God made the Egyptian women amenable to giving their riches to the Hebrew women. The Hebrew women left Egypt after cleaning the Egyptians out.

Think about it; the Hebrews had been slaves for 430 years, how were they to manage years in the wilderness with no resources? God, always giving to us, had this problem solved before the people even knew He was going to relieve them of their horrible life God is a magnificent giver to us; try inviting Him to be in the details of our giving of our prayers, presence, gifts, service, and witness to Him and behold His wonders.
