

Purchase the gift suggested on the tag, wrap it, attach top portion of angel tag to gift and return to the church no later than Sunday, December 3. Each gift should cost between \$20 and \$25. These gifts are for children of an incarcerated parent or family member. The Angel Tree gift pickup day is Saturday, December 9 from 11:00 AM -12:00 PM. Let's show both the children and the incarcerated parent the love of God and make their Christmas a little brighter.


